Many of you know that last November, I expressed concerns about the new owners of ACTC, the Halfway House where we have had several ministry programs for almost six years. I was worried that such a large company would not allow our programs, even though the ACTC staff strongly encouraged the continuation of our ministry programs.

In January, I was informed that we would have to stop all of our programs at ACTC, until Charles and I, both of whom are ex-offenders, completed their extensive application and were approved by the central office. They said it would take about six weeks. Instead it took four months, during which there were no Bible studies, no mountain adventure trips, no attendance at the CHCC Sunday services, no prayer requests, and no coaching and counseling!!!!

Today, I was informed that both Charles and I have been approved and that we can restart our programs, as soon as their corporate office forwards their records. We anticipate restarting our Bible Study this coming Sunday, and soon after, will have a BBQ/celebration at ACTC to get to know all of the new residents and to reestablish our relationships with the men we know.

Thank you all for your prayers and support. Patience is a virtue, Prayer works miracles, and GOD's will shall be done in his timing.
