### **June 13, 2017**

Though the first six months of this year have been very challenging; with the loss of our Community Center, forcing us to hold our programs in various locations; with the sale of the ACTC Halfway House and the new administration taking six months to approve our ministry program; the serious injury to Charles, and the subsequent loss of several volunteers, GOD continues to bless this ministry.

This weekend was amazing. Saturday, we took the homeless youth tubing down Clear Creek, which was flowing strong, and included the challenge of tubing down a waterfall. We had 28 youth attend, the largest attendance we have ever had for an adventure trip. For most of them, it was their first time. They had a great time and wanted to know when we would have another trip!!!!

This Sunday, we had ten homeless youth and ACTC residents attend CHCC. Afterwards we had 25 people attend out Lost & Found Church service at the park.

Our biggest event of the weekend was our first event at ACTC since the new ownership took control. We had a BBQ, several athletic contests, and time to get to know the many new residents. We closed the event with an informal Bible Study discussion and a closing prayer. This was attended by 20 residents. There was great participation by the residents and a spiritual atmosphere of love and peace. Charles, though confined to his wheelchair, and in constant pain, supervised the event and led the Bible Study. His love of GOD, his amazing Bible knowledge, and his sincere concern for these men, enables him to establish an instant rapport with the residents. In the end, the residents were all very thankful and anxious to come to CHCC and start our regular Bible Study, both of which will start next week.
