Today Cherry Hills Community Church was introduced to one of our ACTC Christian residents, Albert Duenas, or Monkey. Several weeks ago, at CHCC, Monkey and Choir Director, Jeremy Richardson, met in the church lobby. A conversation ensued, during which Monkey described how he had journeyed from a drug user, thief, con-artist and prisoner to a devoted follower of Jesus Christ. As a result of that encounter, CHCC videotaped Monkey's testimony, and played it as part of the worship today.

Monkey spent 16 years in and out of prison, living a life of drugs and crime. Due to the ACTC Bible Study, the love Charles, the leader of the Bible Study, has for each of the men at the ACTC Halfway House, and the love the men have for each other; today, Monkey is a free man, walking with Christ.

Monkey is also very active at our Community Center for Homeless youth. Several of the Christian ACTC residents attend our weekly Sunday Worship at the Center and also volunteer on Wednesdays. They have all been a great inspiration to the homeless youth.
