One day each quarter, our Sectional Community, SET THE CAPTIVES FREE; with men from the ACTC Halfway House, our Community Center for Homeless Youth, and some Christian women who prepared the taco meat, helped feed the homeless in Denver.

It all starts in the kitchen and Dining Room of our Community Center, where the tacos are prepared, the bags are filled with a taco, chips, and a cookie. The bags are then placed in a large cooler, with drinks and ice in another cooler. Using four vehicles, we transport the food and volunteers to the inner city of Denver.

In addition to offering a free meal, more importantly we offer prayer, counseling, and discipling for Christ. In two hours, we ministered and fed over 1,500 people!!!
